ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Successful completion of a diploma equivalent to the Secondary School Diploma (SSD) of Quebec and successful completion of the course: Mathematics - Cultural, Social and Technical option (CST) of Secondary 4 or equivalent.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Fill out the online application form and pay the application fee.

Attach the required documents:

- Copies of all your educational documents for the last three years of studies translated into French by an official translator
- · A certified copy of your birth certificate
- · A copy of your passport
- A copy of your Québec Acceptance Certificate (CAQ) issued by the ministère de l'Immigration, Diversité et Inclusion Québec (MIDI) as proof of legal authorization to pursue post-secondary education in Quebec
- A copy of your Study Permit issued by Citizenship and Immigration Canada (CIC)
