


Saint-Jean-Eudes High School has the mission to EDUCATE, SOCIALIZE and CERTIFY

Why choose **Saint-Jean-Eudes**?



Saint-Jean-Eudes is an International Baccalaureate private high school with the highest standards; that hosts over 1000 boys and girls in state of the art facilities with great recognition in the province of Quebec.

- French support classes are included twice a week for all international students;
- Teens are supported all year long by a highly trained staff (tutors, counselors and teachers);
- A welcome committee that helps students integrate into their new school life;
- The only school in Canada that sends a monthly pedagogical report to parents;
- Unique extracurricular activities and international field trips.



This program is predominantly recommended for **teenagers** from 13 to 17 years old. It is the equivalent of grades 7 to 11.

To participate, the student must have previously obtained level A2 in French. Students who have not yet mastered level A2 in French will have the opportunity to register for summer classes with Edu-inter before the first day of school.

Musical Comedy

The student will submerge himself in the vast and rich universe of the scene, more particularly in musical comedy. The student will discover all aspects of the profession: acting technique, dance, singing and staging. At least once a year he will participate in a show in front of the school assembly.

Entrepreneur

It is a program offered to the students who wish to develop their entrepreneurial fiber. This program will enable students to develop skills specific to the socio-economic realities of tomorrow, the entrepreneurial thinking and the intricacies of business.

Discoveries

This profile is for students who want to discover new passions in various areas such as the arts, history, architecture, health or the world of business.

Science & Technology

This program is for creative young people and scientists. It will touch several subjects such as science, robotics, programming and multimedia.

The students in this program will be able to combine their studies with their favorite sport. The profile offers 135 hours of hockey per year.

Languages

The profile offers additional courses in English and in Spanish, and enriched French. This profile is subject to quotas and the student must meet the established prerequisites.

Music

This program allows students to continue their music education through the learning of music instruments (string, wind, percussion). In addition to participating in the wind orchestra, two choices are given to the students: String troupe or Drumline.

Support Program

In addition to providing additional courses in French, mathematics, science and geography, this profile will provide extra courses based on working methods, study strategies, reading, work planning, the management of stress and exam preparation.
