Location and Facilities

The school is centrally located on the Collège Mérici campus in downtown Quebec City, close to major tourist and cultural attractions. On-site facilities include a gymnasium, aerobics room, library, computer labs, an internet cafe, cafeteria, a student lounge and ample green spaces.

- Start dates every week with flexible program duration

The Summer French and Hockey for Teenagers weekly program includes 15 hours of language classes and hockey team training every afternoon. Develop your reading, writing, speaking, and comprehension skills in the morning, and spend your afternoon on ice playing hockey, the Canadian national sport, all in French!

The program is designed for skaters with previous experience and includes team coaching. Games are also planned on a weekly basis. It is a great opportunity to meet local teenagers that share the same interest as you and to know the hockey culture in Quebec City. Improve your abilities to play hockey while practicing French with French-speaking trainers and local hockey players in a complete immersion environment.

Either the homestay or residence option offer our students a complete immersion experience in Quebec City. Our "French only" policy ensure all students speak French at all time.

Requirements

- 10-17 years of age at the start of the program
- Students must bring their own equipment (hockey stick, helmet, gloves, skates, etc.)
- Previous experience in ice skating is mandatory
- It might be possible to rent the equipment for \$125 / week
- Foreign students must meet Canadian visa requirements and have travel and health insurance for the duration of the program
