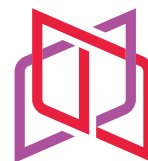

Location and Facilities

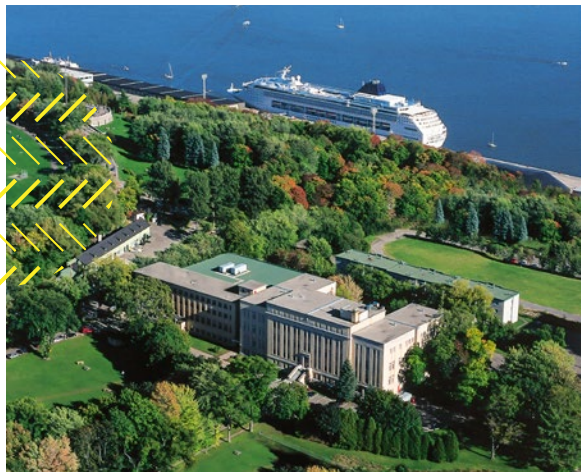

Start Dates

You can start on any Monday of the year!

If a holiday falls on a Monday, the course will start on the Tuesday. From September 2024 to August 2025, the school will be closed on the following dates:

Program Features

- 15 hours of Core French classes per week
