- Start dates every week with flexible program duration

The Summer French & Cooking program includes 15 hours of language classes and 15 hours of Quebec cooking workshops per week. The cooking workshops are offered on-site, at the Collège Mérici's professional cooking training centre and are taught by local professional chefs.
